Living History Event

Who- The Brigades of the American Revolution (BAR) and the <u>Butts Hill Fort</u> will be collaborating on a living history event. This event will involve regiments that fall under the Brigades of the American Revolution (BAR)

What- The mission to educate the public about the American Revolutionary War. This event will give reenactors the time to share their experiences and educate the public about the American Revolutionary War.

When- The event will take place during the first weekend of May. 5/3-5/4. Reenactors may show up on Friday, 5/2, to set up.

How-Reenactment groups may set up camp as desired. Please refer to the map below for your respective locations. The main entrance is wide enough to allow trailers through it. Butts Hill Fort is a historically protected property, and digging is prohibited. Metal plates to protect the surface are permitted for campfires.





Why—The 1778 Rhode Island Campaign has largely been forgotten. Until recently, Rhode Island schools did not teach it. Holding this event at Butts Hill Fort will give people of all ages an opportunity to learn about this forgotten history.

Bathroom: Portable toilets will be available, including an ADA-compliant one. The building that sits next to Butts Hill Fort is a private business. The owner supports our efforts and will let us access the building, including the bathroom.
